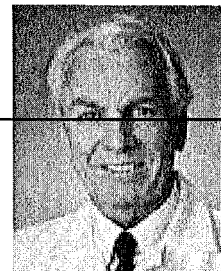

### Samuel Lang, M.D.

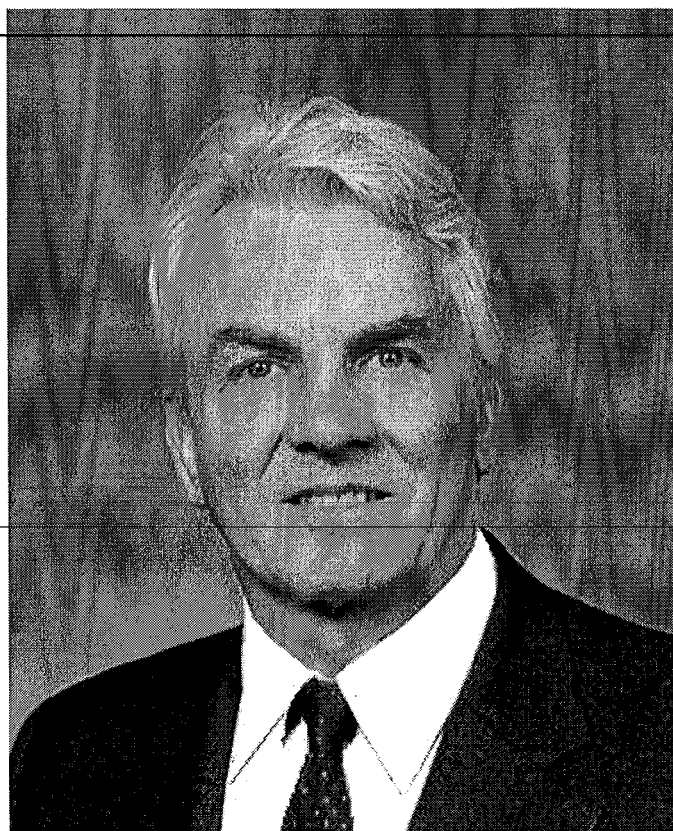
