## New Center for Womens Health Opens In New York City

## First New York City Medical Practice to Offer Two New Women's Health Services For Family Planning and Infertility

New York, NY -- December 8, 2009 -- Gianna -- The Catholic Healthcare Center for Women, sponsored by Saint Vincent Catholic Medical Centers (Saint Vincent's), held a blessing and ribbon cutting today to celebrate the opening of the Center, which will offer women both primary care and specialized OB/GYN care in the same office. The Center committed to providing authentically Catholic healthcare for women consistent with Catholic medical ethics. The opening was timed to coincide with the Feast of the Immaculate Conception.

"We are very pleased, and it is appropriate that we are here today on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception to open the Gianna Center," said Sister Dorothy Metz, president of the Sisters of Charity and sponsor of Saint Vincent's. "The Center offers Catholic women, as well as women of other faith traditions, a new alternative for comprehensive healthcare including primary care, obstetrics, natural family planning, and treatment for infertility that honors their dignity and the sanctity of human life."

The Center's two new programs - the Creighton Model FertilityCare System and NaProTechnology -- follow the Ethical and Religious Directives for Catholic

The Creighton Model FertilityCare System involves a modern approach to natural family planning. It helps women identify the physical signs of fertility, and can be used to achieve or avoid pregnancy with a high rate of effectiveness.


NaProTechnology is a new approach to managing women's reproductive and gynecologic disorders that works cooperatively with the woman's naturally-occurring fertility cycle to correct underlying problems. Based on 30 years of research, NaProTechnology has made it possible for physicians who use this approach to help infertile couples conceive a pregnancy. NaProTechnology is believed to be as successful as IVF, but unlike IVF, does not create or destroy embryos, making it acceptable to people of all faith traditions.

"Among the services that we are providing, NaProTechnology makes it possible for us to help couples conceive children in a manner respecting their dignity," stated Dr. Kyle Beiter, attending obstetrician and gynecologist at Gianna.






